

EQUIFAX BREACH

Equifax, a consumer credit reporting agency, recently disclosed that it experienced a data breach that exposed the personal information of millions of US consumers. Equifax, considered to be one of the three largest American credit agencies, reported that based on its investigation, criminals had gained access to certain files from mid-May through July 2017.

The information accessed primarily includes names, Social Security numbers, birth dates, addresses, credit card numbers and, in some instances, driver's license numbers.

As always, PA Central Federal Credit Union wants to let you know that we are constantly monitoring your PA Central Debit Card activity and PA Central VISA Credit Card activity for suspicious behavior.

Please use Virtual Branch Online Banking and the PA Central Mobile App to monitor your credit union accounts on a regular and frequent basis, and report any suspicious activity to us.

In short, while your personal information on file with us is not connected to the Equifax breach, we continue to keep your personal and financial security our highest priority.
